In spite of the challenging times, Tri-Lakes Women's Club (TLWC) members once again answered the call to do even more to help the Tri-Lakes community. Over \$10,800 was donated by members this year to support the club's 2019- 2020 grantmaking and community support efforts.

"We are so grateful and want to thank our club members for stretching their generosity this year," said Jan McKinley, TLWC Co-President. "This was a huge boost for our charitable events budget, since the organization's annual Spring Show was canceled this year due to Covid-19 restrictions." Monetary gifts of all sizes were donated directly to the club for a total of \$8,555 that will be designated to help fund a portion of the organization's 2020 community grants.

TLWC members also donated an additional \$2290 in cash along with 300 pounds of food in May specifically for Tri-Lakes Cares. The food drive and fundraiser were organized in response to help the resource center during the pandemic. "Our mission has always been to support the Tri-Lakes community through charitable endeavors," said McKinley. "We are fortunate that this year was no different."
